Example: 'oo' – pool, tool, stool

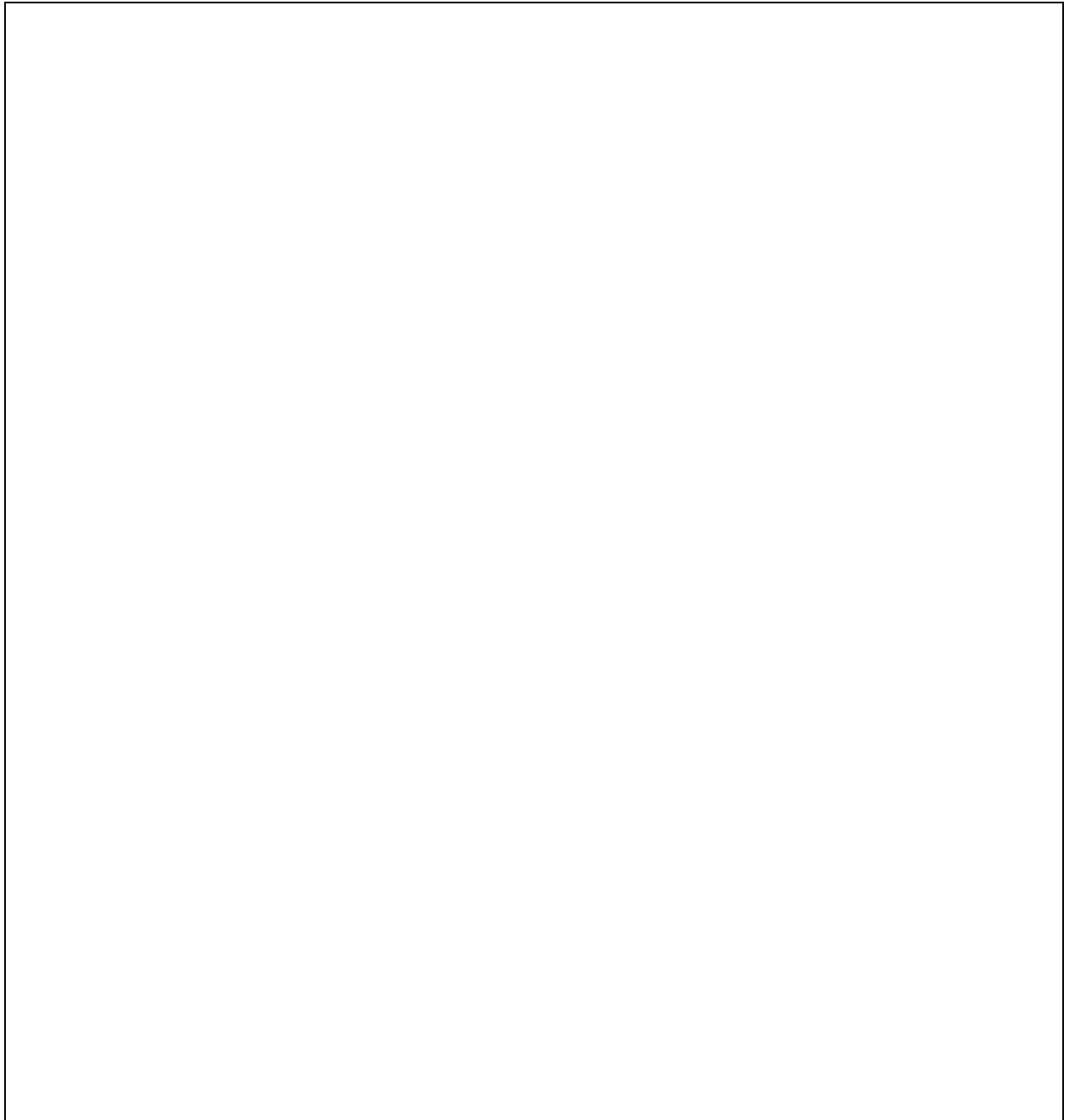




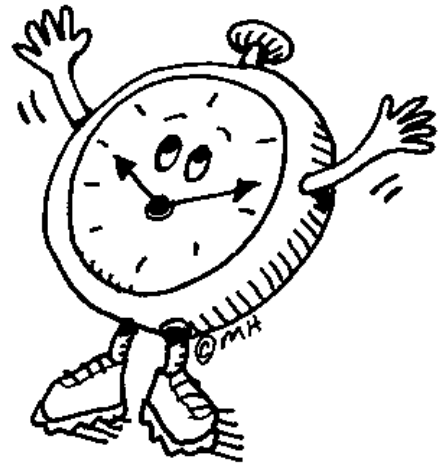
Look at each picture. Sound of the first letter of each word. Write them in the box to make a new word. The first one has been done for you.

Art and Craft Activity

Pot Painting

Materials Required:

- Enamel Paints (Different Colours)
- Brush
- Water
- Earthen Pot
- Container

Procedure:

1. At first, colour your earthen pot with any enamel paint.
2. Now take a container containing three-fourth quantity of water and spill different colours of enamel paints into it.
3. The different colour paints float on the water.
4. Now gently hold your painted pot at its edge and dip it into the water and twist it around, in the water and slowly take it out of the container.
5. Keep the pot aside without disturbing it.
6. The wet paints will slowly take its own design and shade.
7. Wait till the pot dries.
8. Decorate it with your own creativity.

Your pot painting is ready.

Tips :

- The more shades of paints you spill in the water, the more colourful and beautiful the pot will become.
- Do not disturb or shake the pot after it is taken out of the water.

The decorated pots (duly labelled) should be handed over to the class teacher by 20th August'2010.
